Guerin Therapy Group (private practice in Raleigh, NC) is seeking a fully or provisionally licensed mental health therapist to join our growing private practice. We see individuals' challenges as wise ways of coping from trauma, attachment injuries, and sensory sensitivities. Therapists have the opportunity to work both in-person at Current Wellness and remotely via telehealth. They can set their own schedule, but in-person hours will be somewhat determined by the office space available. We currently have a waitlist for clients, and anticipate the new contract therapist's caseload to fill within 3-6 months. This position will begin at part-time and then have the

opportunity to grow into full-time. We handle the credentialing process and getting paneled with insurance companies.
